Deputy Bryan Statzer PSN 222 Operations Division

SYNOPSIS

On September 16, 2001, Deputy Bryan Statzer transported a female subject to the county jail for incarceration. While waiting for the prisoner to be admitted into the jail, Deputy Statzer learned that the Dayton Police Department broadcast a signal 99-officer in trouble. Deputy Statzer then allegedly began yelling at the jail staff to immediately admit the female prisoner and later made a statement that he would soon be assigned to the jail and that they would either be working together or not at all.

INVESTIGATION

During the first week of January 2002, Chief Deputy Rankin told me that a complaint was pending against Bryan Statzer and that the complaint arose from an incident at the jail. Chief Rankin said that since Bryan Statzer had since been promoted and assigned to the jail, the investigation was to be conducted by the Inspectional Services Unit.

On January 7, 2002, I received a memorandum from Major Drummer describing the incident involving Deputy Bryan Statzer. The memorandum also stated that the comments allegedly made by Deputy Statzer were directed to Corrections Officer Paula Agee. Major Drummer stated that he would be the complainant in this matter.
