Court Services Deputy Roy Seely PSN 238 Jail Division

SYNOPSIS

On January 10, 2002, Court Services Deputy arrested Mr. Randy Banks at the Montgomery County Juvenile Court Intervention Center on a warrant. Court Services Deputy Seely failed to confirm the warrant prior to arresting Mr. Banks. After Mr. Banks was admitted to the jail, the jail staff was unable to find a warrant to sustain Mr. Banks detention. Mr. Banks was released from custody after approximately one hour.

INVESTIGATION

On January 11, 2002, I was contacted by Chief Deputy Rankin who advised me that on January 10, 2002, Court Services Deputy Roy Seely arrested Mr. Randy Banks for a warrant. After Mr. Banks was admitted to the jail, the warrant could not be found and Mr. Banks was released from the jail after being held approximately one hour.

Chief Deputy Rankin advised me that he had initiated an administrative investigation and that the investigation was to be completed by the Inspectional Services Unit.

I received a copy of an e-mail from Sergeant Dave Hale to Lieutenant Mike Hild describing the incident and the actions taken by the jail staff in attempting to confirm a warrant for Mr. Banks. I also obtained a copy of the Suspect/Arrestee Supplement completed by Court Services Deputy Seely.

I ran a warrant check on Mr. Banks through the Sheriff's Office Communications Center and found no outstanding warrants. I checked with the Dayton Municipal Court and found an outstanding warrant for Mr. Banks. The warrant for Mr. Banks
