SYNOPSIS

Deputy Vitali alleged that after conducting a search of a residence that yielded marijuana, paraphernalia and a handgun, Sergeant Doran instructed him to take no action and to "walk away." Deputy Vitali also alleged that after conducting a search of a motor vehicle that yielded marijuana and a handgun, Sergeant Doran instructed him to make a physical arrest of the driver on minor misdemeanor charges. He stated that when he disagreed with the legality of that course of action, she publicly berated him and behaved unprofessionally. Deputy Vitali also alleged that Sergeant Doran told him that he was unfit and removed him from duty and then denied doing so. Deputy Vitali also alleged that he and Sergeant Doran engaged in a consensual sex act while on-duty.

INVESTIGATION

On January 16, 2002, I was contacted by Deputy Dave Concannon who advised me that he had been contacted by Deputy Jay Vitali about filing a complaint against Sergeant Shirley Doran. Deputy Concannon explained that it was a very serious matter and requested my assistance. Deputy Concannon said that the complaint involved reports that had been falsified at the instruction of Sergeant Doran and consensual sexual conduct between Sergeant Doran and Deputy Vitali while on-duty. Due to the unusual and serious nature of the allegation, I told Deputy Concannon that I would take the complaint directly as it would undoubtedly be assigned to the Inspectional Services Unit. Deputy Concannon told me that Deputy Vitali was aware
