SYNOPSIS

On December 12, 2001, Attorney William Dulaney addressed a group of students at Bellbrook High School regarding a mock trial. At that time he related an incident to the students alleging inappropriate and criminal behavior by deputy sheriffs of the Montgomery County Sheriff's Office.

INVESTIGATION

In December 2001, Chief Deputy Rankin contacted me and advised me of an allegation of employee misconduct made by Attorney William Dulaney to a group of students at Bellbrook High School. Chief Deputy Rankin told me that the information was initially received through Major Gary Drummer and that documentation of the incident would be sent to Major Drummer and would be forwarded to me for an administrative investigation.

I spoke with Major Drummer who advised me that he was contacted by a friend, Miss Stacy Frank, who is a teacher at Bellbrook High School. Major Drummer said that Miss Frank called him and reported that Attorney William Dulaney had addressed a group of her students at a mock trial and during that time he related an incident involving employees of the Montgomery County Sheriff's Office that clearly indicated inappropriate and criminal behavior. Major Drummer told me that Miss Frank was uncomfortable with this information being disseminated to the students because it had no relevancy to the mock trial and appeared to be an unwarranted tirade against law enforcement.
