9 **SYNOPSIS**

10 On Friday, July 12, 2002, Montgomery County Service Technician Dave Stump was
11 performing service on Sheriff's Office vehicle #8559. While performing the service,
12 Technician Stump discovered the front portion of the car's undercarriage, fan, and fan
13 shroud was damaged. Deputy Talmadge Crosby is the deputy primarily assigned to
14 operate vehicle #8559.

16 **INVESTIGATION**

17 Sergeant Anderson investigated this complaint by interviewing Deputy Crosby, Fleet
18 Manager Tom Munday, Montgomery County Sheriff's Office Volunteer Jerry Wilson,
19 and Montgomery County Service Technician Dave Stump. Sergeant Anderson's
20 investigation shows that the allegation does not have merit concerning Deputy
21 Talmadge.

23 **CONCLUSION OF FACT**

24 Sergeant Anderson's investigation shows that vehicle #8559 was serviced on April 2,
25 2002, without any damage to the undercarriage being noticed. The damage was
26 discovered during the next service on July 12, 2002. Sergeant Anderson's
27 investigation shows that although Deputy Crosby is the primary operator of vehicle
28 #8559, there were five times between April 2, 2002 and July 12, 2002 that the car was
29 driven by someone other than Deputy Crosby. Further, Sergeant Anderson was
30 unable to determine who drove the car on those occasions.
