10 SYNOPSIS

11 On Wednesday, May 8, 2002, Butler Township Patrolman Jason Carter arrested and  
12 transported Rochelle White to the Montgomery County Jail. Corrections Officer  
13 Felicia Foster booked White into the jail. Officer Foster recorded that White had  
14 \$388.41 with her when she entered the jail.

16 When Jail Accountant Gina Rigler counted and deposited White's money, she found  
17 the envelope contained \$338.21, a difference of \$50.20. Accountant Rigler notified  
18 the on-duty Sergeant, Sergeant Dave Hale, and advised him of the discrepancy.

20 INVESTIGATION

21 Sergeant Hale investigated this complaint by interviewing Patrolman Carter, Officer  
22 Foster, and Accountant Rigler. Sergeant Hale also attempted to interview White, but  
23 she failed to respond to any of his requests. Sergeant Hale found that the complaint  
24 did not have merit. (See Sergeant Hale's investigative report).

26 CONCLUSION OF FACT

27 On Wednesday, May 8, 2002, Butler Township Patrolman Jason Carter arrested  
28 Rochelle White and transported her to the Montgomery County Jail. Patrolman  
29 Carter, before transporting white to the jail, counted White's money in front of her.  
30 However, Patrolman Carter does not recall how much money White had with her.
